SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. ALL ANIMALS must be registered with the AJCA with the exception of steers.
- 2. Original registration certificate is required at check-in.
- **3.** All cattle entered must have a legible tattoo to match the corresponding ear location and tattoo as listed on the animal's registration certificate.
- **4.** Tattoos will be verified at the discretion of the TJCA Advisory Committee.
- 5. Fitting is optional. Cattle may be exhibited fit or blow and go.
- 6. No heifers exceeding 30 months of age will be eligible to show.
- 7. All decisions of the TJCA and/or any Appointed Advisory Committee are FINAL.
- 8. The Texas Junior Chianina Association retains the right to verify parentage via hair and/or blood sample at any TJCA sponsored event. Failure to comply will result in disqualification from the event.
- 9. Fans are permitted. Generators encouraged.
- 10. Bedding MUST be purchased at the show. \$8 per bag
- 11. Additional Stalls may be purchased \$30 per stall
- 12. Stall as you arrive
- 13. ALL steers welcome! Jackpot Steer Show and Showmanship
- **14.** Exhibitors MUST show in the t-shirt provided at check-in(TJCA heifer show)

ELIGIBILITY AND OWNERSHIP

TEXAS JUNIOR CHIANINA MEMBERSHIP:

All exhibitors entering the show must be in good standing with the TJCA. Annual membership dues of \$25 (initial member) \$15 (additional family member junior member) per calendar year (January 1 - December 31).

If dues have not been paid, they can be submitted in the showman app with your entries. Membership payment verification will be made upon check-in. Any outstanding dues must be paid at that time in order for show eligibility.

OWNERSHIP:

All exhibitors must present the original registration certificate upon check-in. <u>Registration of the animal must be solely in the name of the junior member of which is</u> <u>exhibiting the animal.</u> Any registration that is presented in the name of a Family Name/ Ranch Name/Breeder/Group in lieu of the exhibitor will NOT BE ELIGIBLE. Therefore the exhibitor will become INELIGIBLE to show. Ownership must be completed with the original registration certificate prior to the start date of the show. NO PENDING REGISTRATION or photocopies will be accepted at check-in.

The Texas Junior Chianina Association is not responsible for verfiying, nor the resolution of ownership and/or issues regarding the registration of cattle. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to settle any outstanding issue with the AJCA prior to the Texas State Junior Chianina Show.
